

Level 3 Award in Wines & Spirits Scholarships and Prizes

The Level 3 Champagne Scholarship, India

High achieving graduates who studied in India will be invited to an interview application. The award is a study tour to Champagne arranged by the Bureau du Champagne in India.

FINE Wine & Champagne India Prizes

A one year subscription to the print edition of FINE Wine & Champagne India Magazine and the e-reader is awarded to all candidates from India achieving Pass with Distinction for their Level 3 Award in Wines & Spirits.

The Bunch Award

Six cases of fine wine are awarded to a top Level 3 graduate who is employed within the wine and/or spirits trade.

The Conseil Interprofessionnel du Vin de Bordeaux Scholarship

A place on the 3-day Grands Crus course at the Bordeaux Wine School as a guest of the Conseil Interprofessionnel du Vin de Bordeaux is awarded to two high achieving graduates from either Germany, Belgium, Switzerland, Holland, or Denmark.

Decanter Scholarships

Three educational bursaries of £3,000 each towards Level 4 Diploma course fees are available to top Level 3 graduates from Greater China, Hong Kong & Macau and Japan. Only candidates who are self-funded are eligible.

High achieving graduates from the UK are invited to a viva voce exam for the following scholarships and prizes.

The Conseil Interprofessionnel du Vin de Bordeaux Scholarship

A place on the 3-day Grands Crus course at the Bordeaux Wine School as a guest of the Conseil Interprofessionnel du Vin de Bordeaux is awarded to two high achieving graduates from UK wine trade.

The Michael Cox Vintners' Award

A bursary to be used for a study trip to a wine and/or spirit producing region is awarded to a high achieving UK graduate.

This award is sponsored by the Worshipful Company of Vintners.

The Patrick Sandeman Vintners' Award

A bursary to be used for a study trip to a wine and/or spirit producing region is awarded to a high achieving UK graduate.

This award is sponsored by the Worshipful Company of Vintners.

The John Avery Vintners' Award

A bursary to be used for a study trip to a wine and/or spirit producing region is awarded to a high achieving UK graduate.

Eligible candidates will be contacted by WSET® Awards after the end of each academic year. Candidates are advised their information may be released to interested parties.

The Rhône Prize

A silver-plated wine cooler, held by the winner for a year, and a case of Rhône wines selected by Hallgarten Wines is awarded to a high achieving graduate from the UK wine trade.

The Champagne Academy Scholarship

A place on the Champagne Academy study course and an invitation to join the Academy is awarded to a high achieving graduate from the UK wine trade.

The Gran Orden de Caballeros del Vino Scholarship

One year's Honorary Membership of the Gran Orden de Caballeros, and a study trip to Spain as a guest of the Gran Orden de Caballeros del Vino.

This prize is offered by Wines of Spain to be awarded to one high achieving graduate from the UK wine trade.

Decanter Prizes

Two high achieving UK non-trade graduates are each awarded a one year subscription to Decanter magazine and a double ticket to the Decanter Fine Wine Encounter.

Porter & Laker Prize

A high achieving graduate from the UK wine trade is awarded £850 towards Diploma course fees by Porter & Laker. The winner's company is awarded £350 for subscription to The Benevolent – the drinks industry charity.

The Incorporation of Coopers Earl of Wessex Scholarship

A graduate from the UK wine trade is awarded a visit to a cooperage and a whisky blending session in Glasgow.

The Oddbins Scholarship

A bursary of £1,000 to be used for a study trip to a wine and/or spirit producing region is awarded to a high achieving UK non-trade graduate.

The Julian Brind Scholarship

A bursary of £1,000 to be used for a study trip to a wine and/or spirit producing region is awarded to a high achieving UK graduate.
